

Sitting in the sun.


In a big fish.

At home.










## How did Jonah feel about being in Nineveh?


#### Did God destroy Nineveh like Jonah wanted Him to?


### Was it wrong that Jonah was angry that God didn't punish them?

He made a plant grow where Jonah was siting to give shade.


He gave him what he wanted.
